**CHRISTMAS WELSH MARKET EVENT**

**SATURDAY 23RD NOVEMBER 2019 - PERMISSION TO TRADE**

1. This permission is granted by The London Welsh Centre to  
\_\_\_\_\_ (“the Trader”)
2. Subject to the payment by the Trader to LWC of an agreed pitch fee \_\_\_\_\_ the Trader is permitted to occupy and trade from a stall within allocated by LWC for the purposes of selling items as agreed with LWC on Saturday 23rd November 2019 between the hours of 11.00am and 6.00pm and to use the facilities provided therewith. Limited Electricity will be allocated on a First come, first served basis.
3. In exercising this permission the Trader shall:
  - 3.1 display legibly and prominently his or her name and address
  - 3.2 keep his or her stall and the immediately surrounding area clean, tidy, and free from litter, spillages, and dispose of refuse in the receptacles provided
  - 3.3 comply with all reasonable directions given by any Authorised Officer of Camden Council or any Police Officer in relation to the positioning of his or her stall and goods and the conduct of his or her stall
  - 3.4 at all times keep his or her goods and stock within the area of the stall
  - 3.5 comply with the requirements of the emergency services in the event of emergency service vehicles requiring access to any part of the Scheme Area
  - 3.6 remove all receptacles/rubbish and goods from the Scheme Area within one hour of the end of the permitted hours
  - 3.7 treat all members of the public and officers of Camden Council with courtesy and ensure that any staffs employed do likewise
  - 3.8 comply with all requirements of the Environmental Protection Act 1990, the Food Safety Act 1990 and the Health and Safety at Work Act 1974
  - 3.9 On demand, produce this permission to any authorised official of the LWC.
4. In exercising this permission the Trader shall not:
  - 4.1 encroach onto or in any way obstruct the pedestrian routes in front of the stall.
  - 4.2 sell, display or wear any article or items of clothing, which is or is intended to be or is considered by any Authorised Officer of the Council to be offensive by either writing, picture or the nature of the article or item.

- 4.3 trade outside the Permitted Hours
- 4.4 sell or display any live animal, bird, fish, reptile or insect
- 4.5 display any advertising material, which promotes the sale of goods or services which are not available from him or her

5. This permission may be terminated forthwith by the LWC verbally in the event of breach by the Trader of any of the obligations imposed by Clauses 3 and 4 above and upon such termination; the Trade shall immediately remove his stock, goods and possessions from the stall.
